

(Minimalist MotorHome)

The van: Dacia Dokker Van – same dimension as Renault Kangoo:



Behind the driver: the sofa during the day, bed during the night with storage below:



On the other side of the van: storage shelfs with a folding table:





The table is folded when not used. Can be used as desk, or cooking space with a gaz cooker and water:







The WC is below the bed:

And that's it :-) All you need in 4m²

The advantage is that you can't see it is a motorhome, so you don't have any of the restrictions that they face in many countries.

Yes, you don't have much space, but I have rented motorhomes before and I realized you are never in it, except to sleep. I have the car radio and a portable PC with the phone for internet connection.

As long as I can make a cup of coffee in the morning and a soup at night, it is more than enough.

The other advantage is that you can easily take out the elements for the regular national car inspection — so not submitted to special legislation for motorhomes either :-)

If I really need to, I can even take a shower outside with my portable solar shower and my pop-up tent:
